During the current Programming Period the LIFE Programme has two sub-programmes:

The **Environment** sub-programme

- i. Environment and Resource Efficiency
- ii. Nature and Biodiversity
- iii. Environmental Governance and Information

The **Climate Action** sub-programme

- i. Climate Change Mitigation
- ii. Climate Change Adaptation
- iii. Climate Governance and Information

WE SUBSIDIZED THE PARTICIPATION OF 4 PEOPLE IN EU EVENTS

The LIFE Cyclamen Project announced 2 Open Calls in 2019, inviting interested parties to request a subsidy for participating in an EU event (conference, workshop, seminar, networking event, etc.) about the environment and climate change.

The aim of the participation was to facilitate the exchange of experience and best practices, and the diffusion of LIFE project results, as well as encourage networking that could possibly lead to the submission of new LIFE Proposals.

The last four applicants who were able to benefit from this Open Call were:

George Fyttis (LIFE Euroturtles) participated in the 42nd International Congress of the Mediterranean Science Commission (CIESM). The Congress was held in Cascais, Portugal between the 7th and 11th of October 2019.

Assist. Professor Michalis Koutinas (CUT, LIFECAB) participated at the Conference ECCE12 & ECAB5, which

was held between the 15th and 19th of September in Florence and included the annual European Congresses of Chemical Engineering and Applied Biotechnology.

Dr Louis Hadjioannou (Enalia Physis Environmental Research Centre) participated at the 54th European Marine Biology Symposium. The Symposium took place in Dublin, Ireland between the 25th and 29th of August 2019.

Dr. Paris Phokaides (Frederick University) attended the 27th European Biomass Conference and Exhibition (EUBCE), which took place in Portugal from the 27th until the 30th of May.

INFO DAY FOR LOCAL AUTHORITIES

WORKSHOP "HOW-TO-WRITE A LIFE PROPOSAL" (FINANCIALS)

The LIFE Cyclamen team organised a Workshop on "How-to-write a LIFE Proposal (Financials / Full Proposal)", on Tuesday November 19th 2019, at the Department of Environment, in Nicosia.



The workshop was designed for Organisations / Public Bodies, which had succeeded in the Concept Note stage, or which could apply for a LIFE Grant in the 2020 LIFE Call. The aim of this workshop was to highlight best practices for the completion of the financial forms.

PRESS CONFERENCE – LIFE PROGRAMME AND LIFE ORGANIKO

We organised a press event on Wednesday October 9th 2019, in Nicosia. The purpose of the event was to introduce local journalists to the LIFE Programme – EU's funding instrument for the environment and climate action.



During this event, participants had the opportunity to hear more about a Cypriot LIFE Project that was recently completed, namely LIFE ORGANIKO. This project promotes organic farming and organic products on the basis of two great challenges for Cyprus: (a) Childhood obesity, which is turning into a pandemic, with the adoption of a more organic way of living and (b) the combat of climate change with organic farming, which reduces the greenhouse gas emissions.

OPEN DAY FAIR: EMPOWER YOUR ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION WITH EU FUNDING

The LIFE Cyclamen team, in collaboration with the Directorate General for European Programmes, Coordination and Development, the Research & Innovation Foundation and Enterprise Europe Network Cyprus, organised an Open Day Fair on Sunday June 2nd 2019, at the Mall of Cyprus.

The Fair was titled "Empower your environmental action with EU funding" and its purpose was, among others, to give people the opportunity to discuss with the National Contact Point of the LIFE Programme in Cyprus and find out if their idea could be funded under LIFE.
